7th Grade Mandatory Immunizations – In 2016, Governor Brown signed SB277 into law requiring that all student entering the 7th grade show proof of immunizations in order to enroll in public school. Please be aware that the new law only allows exemptions from a medical doctor, personal belief exemptions are no longer allowed. Also, please be aware that students enrolling in 7th grade must be up to date with all required immunizations, not just the required 7th grade Tdap booster. **Student will not be allowed to attend school in August without all their immunizations.** Parents of our 7th grade students have already received two reminder letter. Please don't wait until it's too late. Get your child immunized today.
