**TWAIN HARTE SCHOOL DISTRICT** affirms that the safety and security of our students and staff is essential if our school is to accomplish its primary mission, educating the youth of our community. In recognition of this, we have developed Emergency Response Procedures and Guidelines as part of our School Safety Plan. This guide outlines the steps that students and staff can follow to effectively respond to a variety of emergencies. Periodically we conduct emergency safety drills. These drills include fire, bus evacuations, secure school and lockdowns. In case of a real emergency, parents/guardians will be notified by our school alert system. In lieu of this, it is very important that the school office has up-to-date emergency contact information for all students. Please make sure you let the office know if your emergency information changes.

**HOLIDAY FOOD DRIVE –** Our 8<sup>th</sup> grade class and Student Body Association in conjunction with ATCAA will be working together to run this year's holiday food drive. Red collection barrels are located in the hallway by the school office and in the upper building's middle room.
