3.1 Superintendent/Principal Report

- New staff was introduced to the board
- Current attendance rate is 95.7%. Attendance is an area of improvement goal for this year, based on last year's 67% chronic absenteeism rate. This year we are actively communicating the importance of getting students to school with families that have attendance challenges. We have had 2 SARB meetings to date stressing the importance of student attendance.
- Another goal this year is to focus on Math and Math fundamentals. We offered virtual training on our new math curriculum for our teachers over the summer. Next week we have in-person training scheduled to answer any remaining questions about our new math curriculum. We are also implementing a Building Fact Fluency (BFF) program to give our students a solid math foundation. The program uses different hands on games that keep them engaged while building their basic math fluency.
- Athletics: Girls' basketball is in full swing and cross country practice has started. We are currently looking for a wrestling coach.
- Our Williams Review is tomorrow. TCSOS will be on-site to ensure we have adequate text books for all students. They were out last week for the facility portion of the review which went well.
- ELOP- after school program is currently full but they are looking for additional staff which would allow them to open more spots.
- Projects: Upper campus roofing project is complete and looks good. The shade structure project is waiting on a couple of final material certifications and inspections. The building materials are reading to go once we meet these final paperwork pieces. The generator project is waiting for one last part before it can proceed.
- Congratulations to Matt! Matt is now on his bus route.

- The County is looking at shared services for bus routes. Currently we do not see our district as a candidate since most of our routes do not overlap with other bus routes in the county.
- We have filled our Tech position with Josiah Hernandez, we are just waiting on paperwork.
