- Thank you to Tim Hoffman-Brady for your years of dedication and service to the Twain Harte School District Staff and Students. Mr. Hoffman-Brady was presented with a clock listing his years of service.
- Attendance Report Year to date 93.17% compared to 89.06 last year. TK-3 grades improved 4.6%, 4-6 grades improved 5%, 7-8 grades decreased slightly 0.29%
- Student Achievement
 - State Test scores ELA 48.33 % of our students met or exceeded state standards, Math 43.10% met or exceeded state standards, compared to 2020-21 we increased ELA 8.82%, Math 2.98%.
 - District goal: 60% of our students to meet or exceed state standards by the end of the 2023-24 school year.
 - o STAR Reading and Math assessments Tests given the first 2 weeks of school showed 52% of students have met proficiency standards in reading and 45% in math.
 - Students took the second round of STAR assessments this week
 - Writing assessments Writing evaluated last week at a staff meeting. Teachers discussed strengths and weaknesses they observed in their students' writing and steps to be taken for the next assessment in February.
