- 3.1 Superintendent/Principal Report-
- **Academics** Friday the 17th is the end of the first trimester report cards will be sent home. Math, reading and writing test and assessment information will be included on the report cards.
- Attendance- School wide 94.27%, 2nd Grade at 96.18% and 6th Grade at 96.02% have the highest attendance.
- Student/Family Engagement- The Fall Festival was a huge success. An estimated 200-300 people attended including 60% of our students. Thank you to all the staff, parents and students that made this event possible.
- Facilities- Playground fencing and gates have been completed providing a more secure black top area.
 - Architectural Projects- Upper Building fencing current estimate \$160,000
 Lower building restrooms estimated \$290,000 with \$66,000 in architectural and engineering fees (for both projects).
 - Freezer upgrade- we are currently in the quote process for this upgrade.
