SCHOOLWISE ALERT SYSTEM is our primary means of communication to families for announcements, reminders, weather related information, and any other important updates throughout the school year. ATTENDANCE is important to help your student build good school habits. Did you know; Research shows that missing 10 percent of the school year, or about 18 days in most school districts, negatively affects a student's academic performance. That's just two days a month and that's known as chronic absence. By 6th grade, chronic absence becomes a leading indicator that a student will drop out of high school. Please call the office when your student is absent from school. Without verification your student's absence will be marked as unexcused
