**TWAIN HARTE SCHOOL VOLUNTEER POLICIES** will be changing effective July 1, 2025. Updated policies will require that all volunteer positions be fingerprinted prior to volunteering, fingerprints will only be required once. Volunteers will also need to complete a TB risk assessment every four years and will review volunteer policies and mandated reporting requirements yearly.
