7.2 Facility Plan

Mr. Wingo gave information on the state of the facilities:

It is estimated the lower building was built in 1958, the upper building 1974 and the gym 1979. The play structure has approximately 10-15 years of life left. There are plans to do seal-coating and striping of the playground next year. The new sand volleyball area is popular during recess. Roofs of all buildings are generally in good shape (one has a leak during heavy rains that is being investigated so it can be fixed)

HVAC, electrical, plumbing and fencing are ok for now ADA compliance is good

Current concerns are the white crumbling bleachers, upper campus generator does not turn off after auto-starting during a power outage, and there is currently no ADA staff bathroom on the upper campus. Also, the paved area behind the gym/upper classes is uneven and will need some attention.

Class sizes are good with about 250 students and enrollment is expected to stay about the same. Technology was upgraded about 2022 and is adequate.

Steve asked if there was any asbestos or mold abatement that needed to be done Mr. Wingo said single pane windows are on the list to be replaced with double pane, replacing metal doors that are wearing out on upper campus as needed, replacing technology as needed. Steve asked if there were any grants available for installing solar Annabelle said the playground bathrooms need some attention Parisa asked about more filtered water bottle filling stations

Mr. Wingo stated that the final Facility Plan would be going to the board for approval in December.

7.3 Twain Harte School logo and mascot change/discussion

Mr. Wingo explained why the mascot needs to be changed (from the Governor) and said he had tried to obtain permission to remain the Braves but was denied. He said he has been told by some community members they are upset about the change. A couple of early ideas for the school logo and mascot are the Bucks and Cubs. We were asked to start thinking of ideas and would revisit this topic after December.
