ELIGIBILITY PERIODS occur every three weeks, for students in 4th-8th grade, and are based on factors such as attendance, behavior and academics. Please remember that students must remain eligible to participate in extra-curricular activities such as dances, sports, and ski trips. If your student becomes ineligible you will be notified by their teacher as well as receive a notice in the mail.

ATTENDANCE is important to help your student build good school habits. Missing 10% (1-2 days every few weeks) can make it harder for your student to gain reading and math skills, build relationships, and develop good attendance habits. Please call the office when your student is absent from school. Without verification your student's absence will be marked as unexcused.
