- Curriculum/Achievement:
 - Star testing results: Reading Fall 51%-Spring 58%, Math Fall 40%-Spring 53%
 - Teachers are shifting gears to CAASPP prep over the next few weeks.
- Attendance: LY 92.57%, TY 93.77
- Facilities:
 - The maintenance team is working hard to clean up the storm debris, we had significant tree damage. The fence was also damaged and repairs are underway. The team has also been clearing debris along our bus routes to make sure the stops and turn arounds are safe for students and bus drivers.
 - The Developer Fees study is still in progress we will keep the Board informed as this moves forward.
 - We are currently looking into some small rural school facility funding opportunities. We need to wait for Dev. Fee Study to be completed to pursue potential access to this funding.




