In your account you will find forms for all returning students. **Important- If your student is already enrolled do not create a new parent account or start them as a new student; a new student application is only for a student who has not previously attended.** All families will need to upload a current proof of residency and complete household information, including the **Universal Benefits Form**, before gaining access to student forms. Once family info is up to date you will be allowed to update student emergency contacts, and sign forms regarding photo consent, technology use, medical and emergency consent and Smile Keepers.
