LABOR DAY is Monday, September 7th. Campus will be closed for the holiday.

STUDENT DROP OFF; campus opens for student drop off at **7:45am for students eating breakfast and 8:00am for all other students**. There is no supervision for students before these times. Students can be dropped off at the lower building parking lot, the upper building parking lot, or near the bus turnaround. Parents may walk their students to the door or gate using the sidewalk. **We must keep the playground clear of parents and family members in the morning.**

STUDENT PICK-UP the upper campus parking lot is one way only entering from Twain Harte Drive and exiting down the ramp to Cedar Dr. by the fire house. On the lower campus parents are asked to please drive through the two pick up lanes and we will walk your student to your vehicle when you get to the front of the line. To ensure a safe and orderly process we ask that you **please remain in your vehicle during student pick-up.**

- **Staying after school**- If students are not participating in an after-school activity they **may not** stay on campus after school without adult supervision.
